



THANKS FOR THE GAME: THE VERY BEST OF GOLF WITH HENRY COTTON

Cheshire-born Sir Thomas Henry Cotton was the greatest English golfer from the period between the careers of Harry Vardon and Nick Faldo. A pro in 1924, he won his first British Open in 1934 followed by further wins in 1937 and 1948. He was part of four British Ryder Cup teams, won the British PGA three times, and played in his final Open in 1977 – 50 years after making his debut in the tournament. Cotton worked very hard at his game, often practicing until his hands bled, but he always made time for the good life, being a keen imbiber of Champagne and a natty dresser.





Wilson joined Liverpool as a player in 1897. There is one unidentified autograph.

Signed to the reverse by 12 Leicester players from the same season, these individually cut and laid down with glue. They include McLaren, Black, Osborne, Watson, Harrison, Ritchie, Hine, Lochhead, Adock, Chandler, Barry and David Gardner (trainer). Gardner had played for Newcastle United from 1899 and West Ham from 1904.



CURRIE CUP FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT 1908 (SOUTH AFRICA) OFFICIAL HANDBOOK

Official handbook for the 1908 South African Association Football Currie Cup tournament, held between August 19-29, 1908. The inter-provincial tournament was won by Western Province - this was also the first year that Rhodesia entered the competition. The first tournament was played in 1892. Includes articles of constitution, competition rules, history of the Currie Cup, past records, international players, list of fixtures, results page (neatly completed in ink), team colours and full squads, and travel arrangements.




