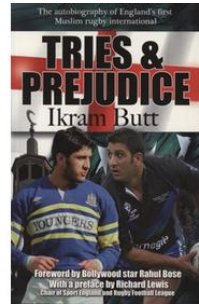

JACK HOBBS & DOUGLAS JARDINE (ENGLAND) 1929 CRICKET PHOTOGRAPH



Rare original black and white Press photo of Jardine and Hobbs walking out to open the batting for the only time together for England - Sutcliffe being ill - against Australia in the Fifth Test at Melbourne, Mar 8-16, 1929. They put on 64 (Jardine 19, Hobbs 142) followed by 1 in the second innings (Jardine 0, Hobbs 65); Hobbs's century was his fifth at Melbourne, his 12th against Australia, both records for an Englishman, and furthermore, at 46 years 83 days, he became the oldest centurion in Ashes history. However, Australia won by 5 wickets as consolation after England had won the first four Tests.

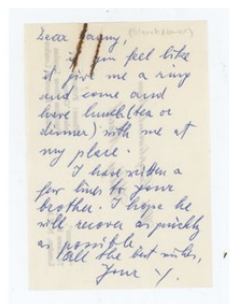

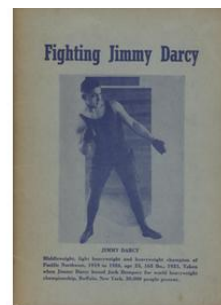

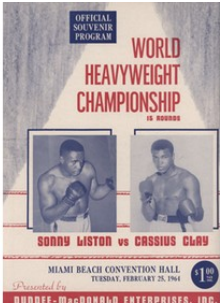

HARRY ALTHAM TO E.W. SWANTON 1960 AIR MAIL CRICKET LETTER

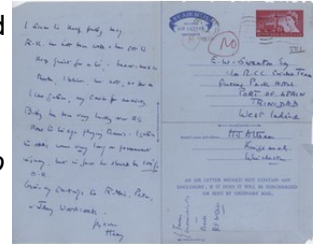

Rough edges where opened with a knife. Good condition. A revealing communication between two great servants of the sport of cricket.

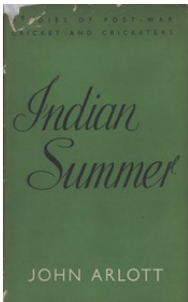

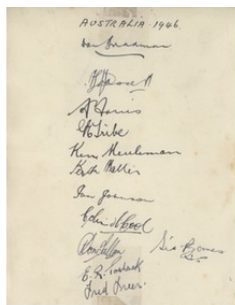

AUSTRALIA 1946-47 (2ND ASHES TEST) CRICKET AUTOGRAPHS



A sheet of 12 Australian cricket autographs from 1946. Research suggests that these were collected during the second Test of the 1946-47 Ashes series, played at Sydney - the players are Bradman, Hassett, Morris, Tribe, Miller, Johnson, McCool, Tallon, Toshack, Freer and Barnes with Meuleman as 12th man. Australia won the match by an innings and 33 runs, with both Bradman and Barnes scoring double centuries. McCool and Johnson did most of the damage with the ball. Barnes has hand signed the sheet and not used a stamp, as he so often did.

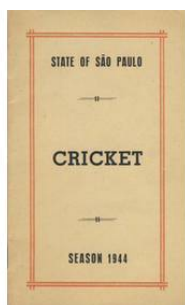

FIRST FRENCH GRAND PRIX 1906 - CIRCUIT DE LA SARTHE (19 POSTCARDS)

19 original postcards. Each published by J. Bouveret of Le Mans from photographs by Maurice-Louis Branger. Includes a map of the circuit and 18 individual drivers (and cars), including the winner Ferenc Szisz and Albert Clement. The 1906 race was the first French Grand Prix and was hosted by the Automobile Club de France (ACF). It was created at the initiative of the French automotive industry as an alternative to the Gordon Bennett Cup.

The Clement postcard has an address written to reverse, and a stamp and short note to front. The Baron de Caters postcard has a long neat message to reverse but has not been posted. All the others are postally unused and in excellent condition.



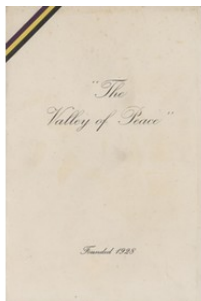

The Athletic club had a lease on Home Park from 1901 but after 1903 it was shared with Plymouth Argyle football club, who still use the stadium today.

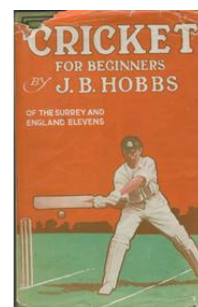

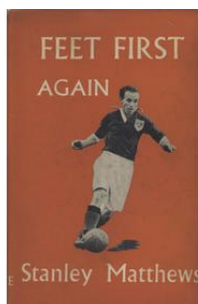

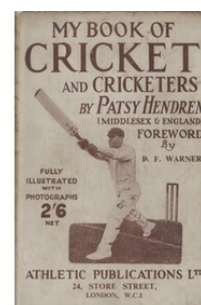
